

Decision: After you evaluate, make a responsible decision, based on evidence.





Ask the Right?

- Begin with a photo. "Visual images level the playing field."
 Quote from principal in Polk County during a summer reading enrichment session
- Ask: What do you see? Encourage students to only tell you what they see in terms of evidence.
- Ask: What do you think? This is where students make inferences based on what they see.
- Ask: What do you wonder? or What questions do you have?
- For more focused inquiry begin with a statement that will lead to standards-based questions.





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
